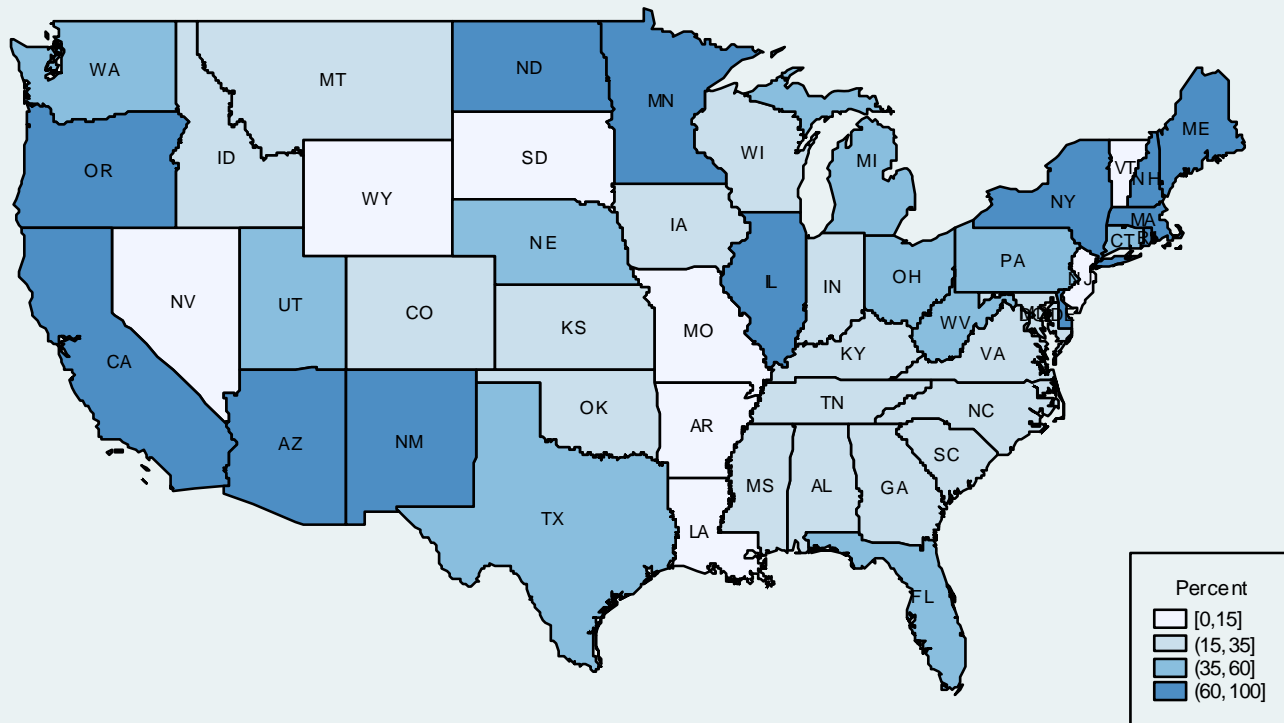

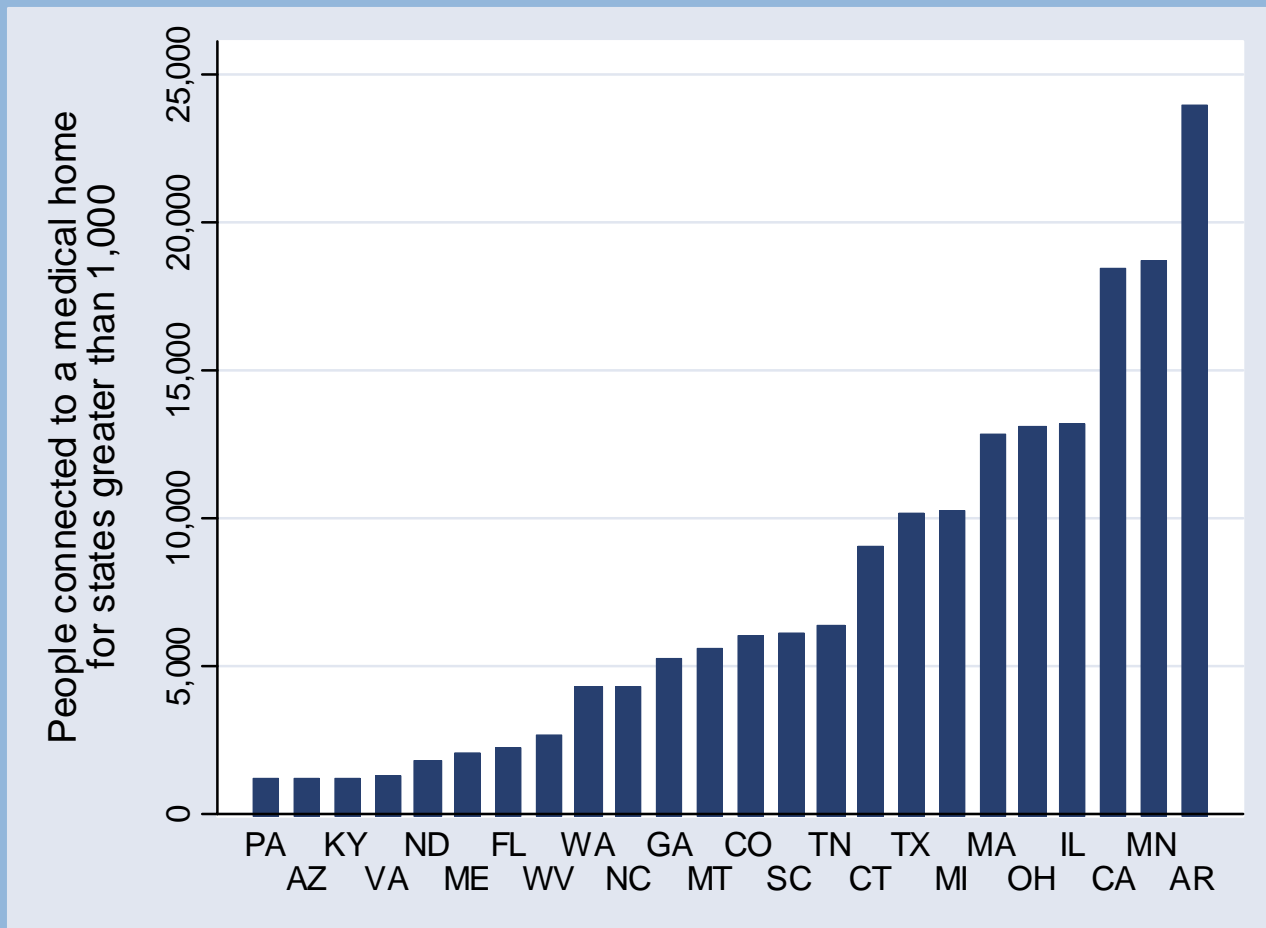

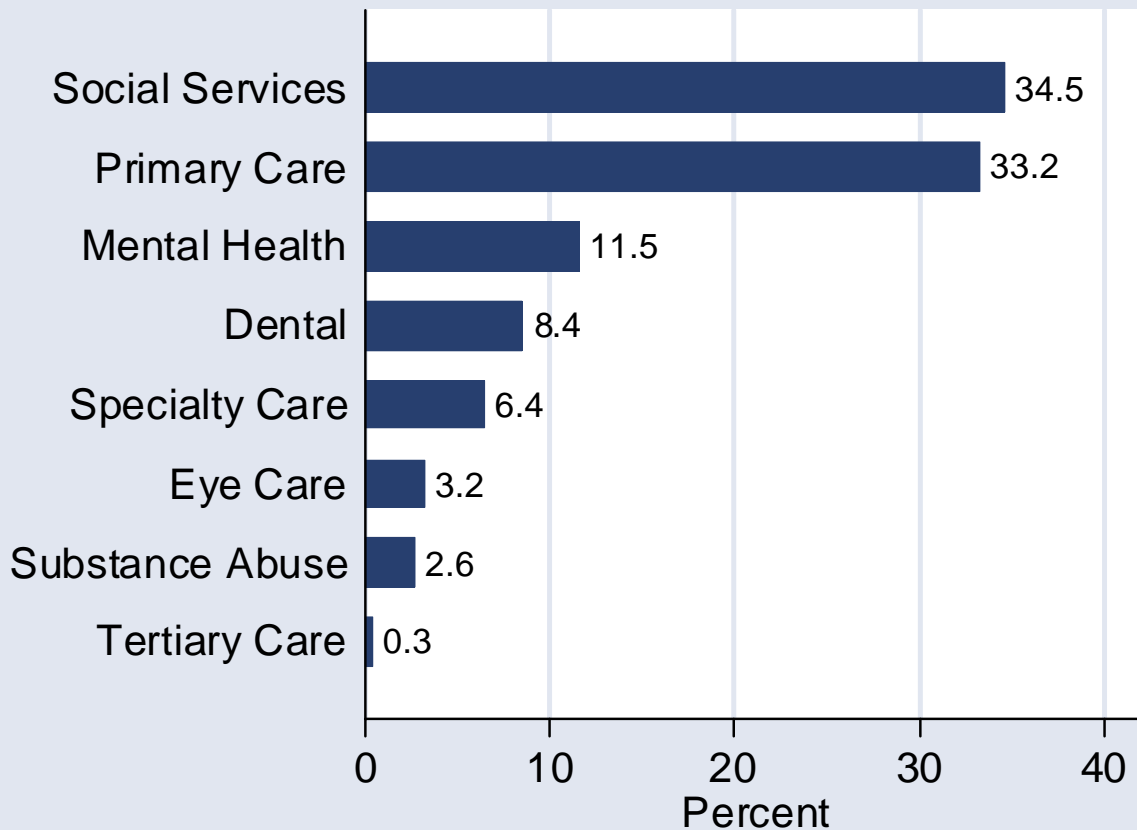
Better Health Through Access to Primary Care

307,708 new services were provided to 615,338 people



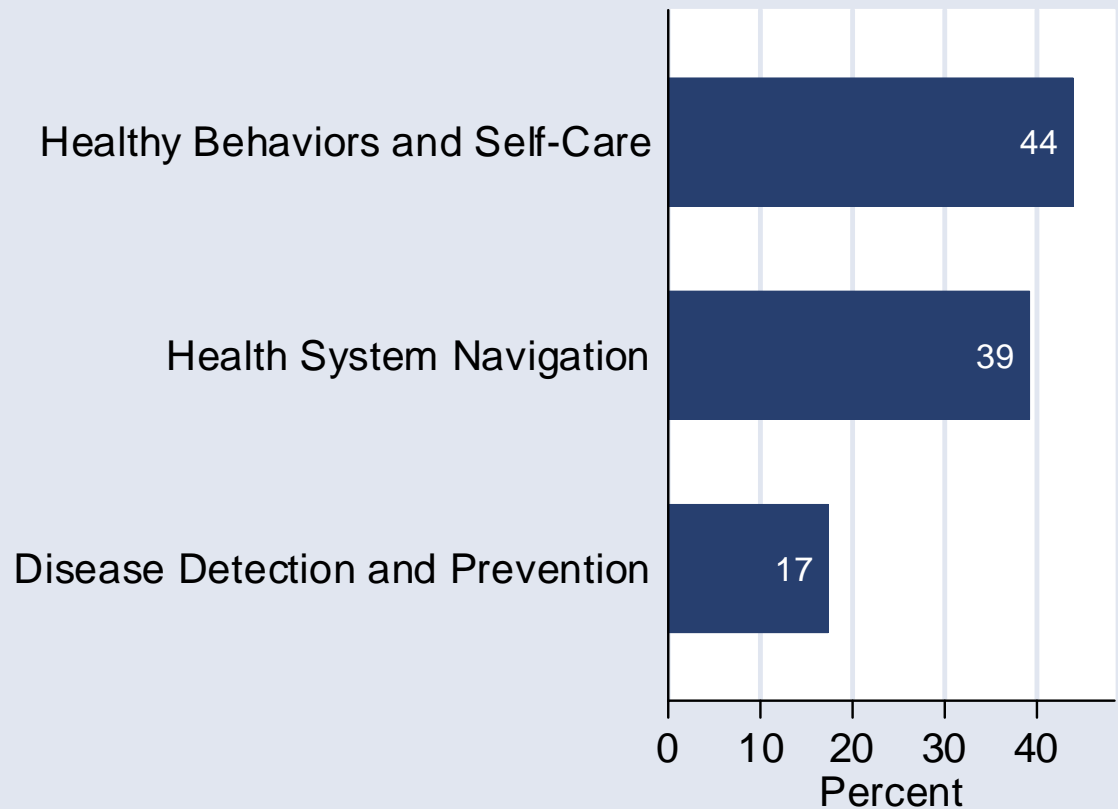
Better Health Because There Is Greater Access to Services

- 378 doctors newly agree to accept public coverage and provide services for 13,045 people
- 22 new and 12 expanded community clinics resulting in over 47,000 patient visits

Better Health Through Patient Education About How to Take Charge

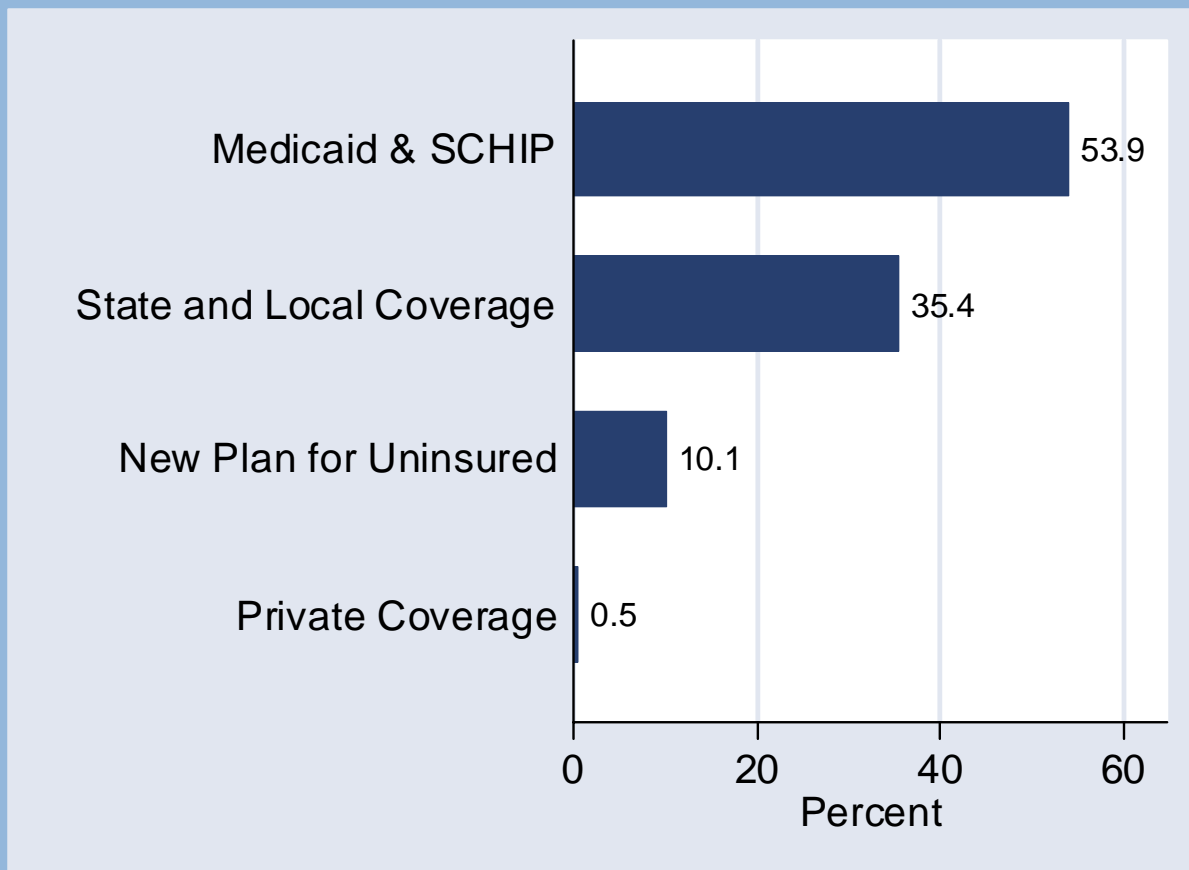

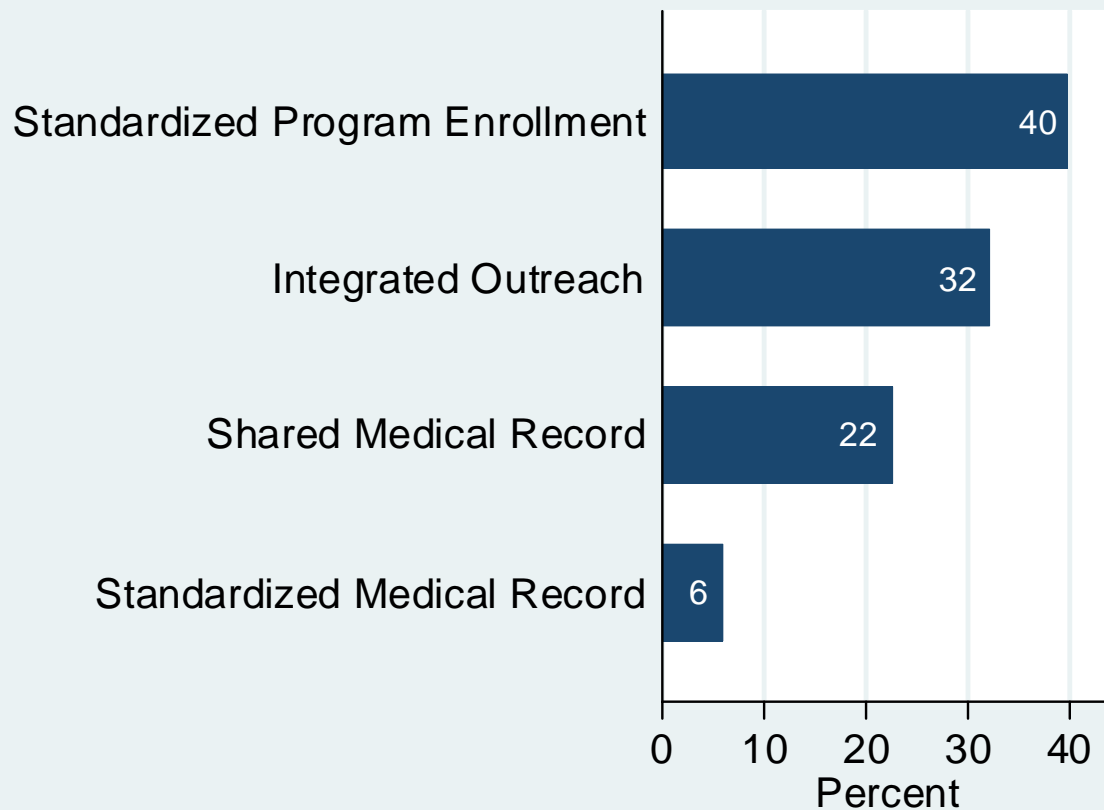
Better Health Through Affordable Coverage

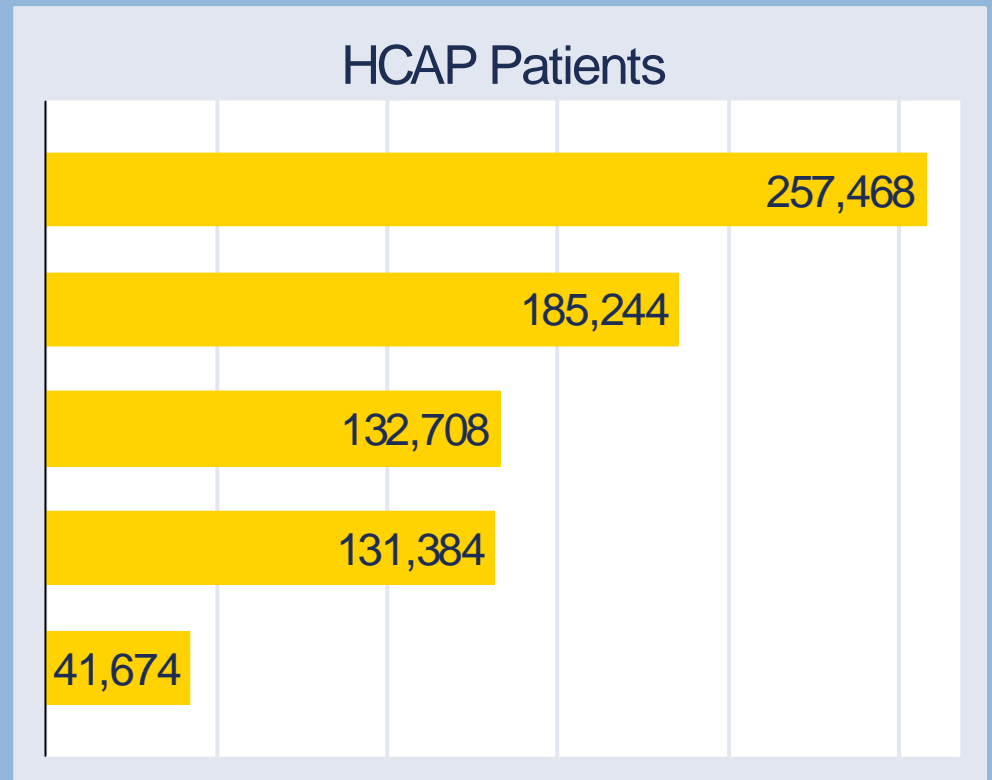

At *Less Cost* Due to Effective Points of Access

The following interventions are proven to reduce the cost of health care

- Received affordable prescription drugs for chronic conditions
- Were found a usual source for primary care (a “medical home”)
- Used the Emergency Room appropriately
- Received interpretive services at appointments
- Called a nurse advice line to triage care

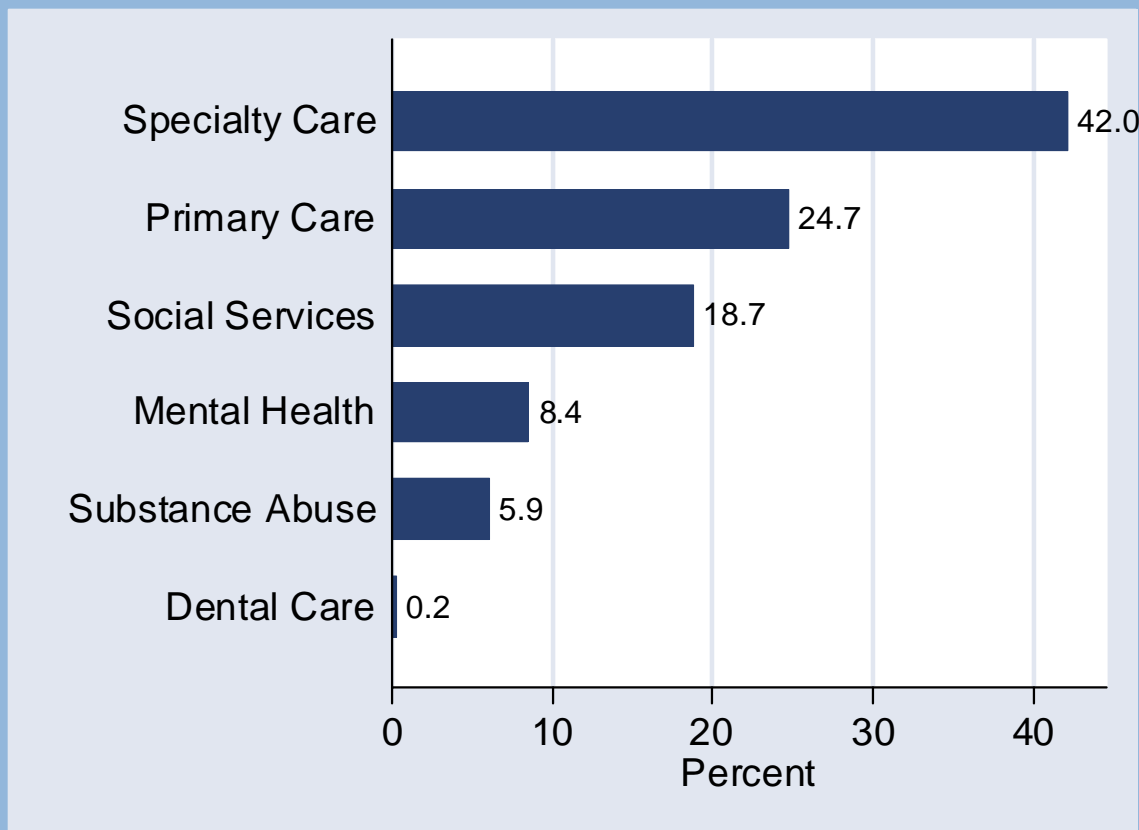




At Less Cost by Reducing Fragmentation

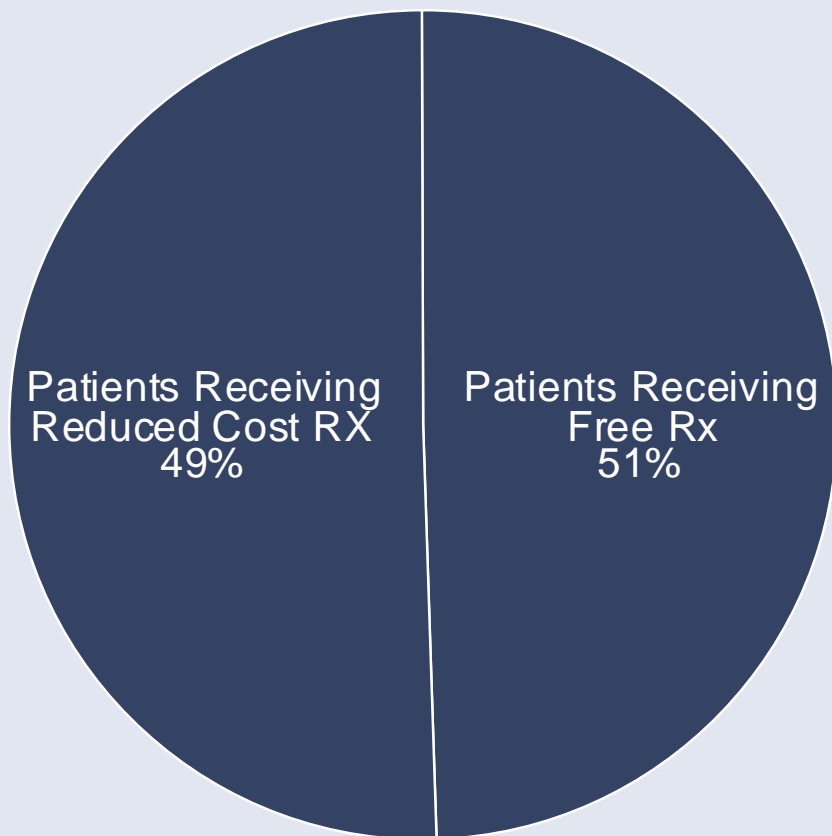
547,133 people received facilitated referrals to necessary services

At *Less Cost* Due to Better Treatment Compliance

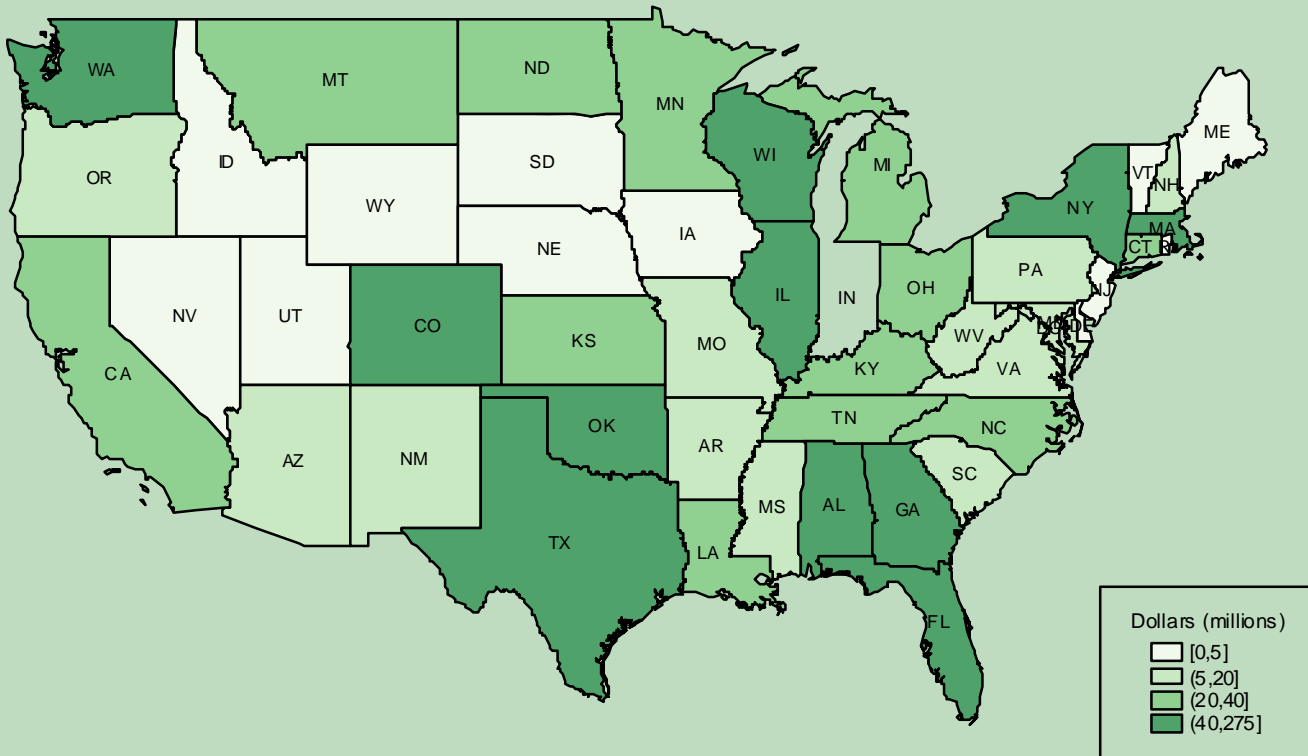


257,468 people had 773,322 prescriptions (Rx) filled. There were 159 newly participating providers
