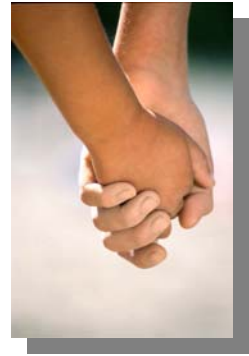


# Oregon-Washington 100% Access Summit
