Health Assistance Fund

The Health Assistance Fund helps people by providing needed healthcare services for individuals who can demonstrate both a need for a health-related service and a lack of financial resources. Health Assistance Fund dollars are always used as a last resort. Therefore, we work with you to connect with other existing community resources and programs as a first resort, or in conjunction with Health Assistance Funds.

Examples of eligible expenses include ur-

gent specialist procedures, prescription medications and diabetic supplies, eye glasses, medical equipment, and health-related transportation passes, though this list is not all-

inclusive. Individuals can receive up to \$250 in assistance each year.



Plan B (Basic Coverage Plan)

Plan B covers basic services, like doctor's office visits, laboratory work, X-rays, and generic medications. To be eligible, you must be a Calhoun County resident between the ages of 19-64 who has no other health coverage and is below the income limits listed here. Enrollment in this program is FREE and the copays for services are very low.

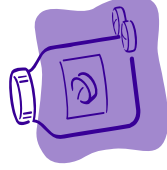

Prescription Drug Access Program

We help people with low income access FREE chronic illness medications through the major pharmaceutical companies' no-cost programs. Enrollment in this program is FREE and the medications you receive are also FREE. Many of our clients receive multiple medications - at no cost!



Referral & Advocacy Program

Under this program, we provide assistance in a wide variety of areas, from referring to other Calhoun County resources to assisting with understanding medical bills and insurance statements. We can help you to understand what healthcare benefits you may qualify for and help you get through the enrollment process.
