The Dentists' Partnership



How do I know if I'm eligible?

In order to be eligible for assistance under the Dentists' Partnership, you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. You must be a resident of Calhoun County;
2. You must **NOT** have dental insurance coverage;
3. You must meet the income limits listed below:

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Max Income</u>
1	\$20,420
2	\$27,380
3	\$34,340
4	\$41,300

Add \$6,960 for each additional family member.

If you meet the three requirements listed above, please call for assistance.



What you should know...

- This program is for urgent and emergency dental needs only.
- You will receive an initial screening and complete program intake information; afterward, you will be placed as quickly as possible with a volunteer dentist. However, in most cases, you must be prepared to wait for an available dentist.
- Basic restorative services, such as fillings and simple extractions, are typically available under this program. Extensive restorative services, such as oral surgery, crowns, and dental prosthetics are typically not available.
- If you need multiple urgent services, you must be prepared to have the most urgent needs served first, and may have to wait to have less urgent needs served.
- All services provided to you are donated by the dentist; however, we ask that you return a *gift of personal significance*, which your Enrollment Specialist will discuss with you.



- This program is completely dependent upon the generosity of community dentists. It is imperative that you appear for scheduled appointments and follow the dentists' recommendations if you are to receive help through the Dentists' Partnership program.
- If you have trouble accessing this service due to transportation, language barriers, or any other special needs, please let us know. We have resources available to help!
