

We are the ones called to take risks.


We are the ones called to change attitudes, to risk displeasures, We are the ones called to gamble our lives for a better world.

Portfolio of Eight Critical Activities tied to best practices demonstrating significant Return on Community Investment (ROCI)

- 1. Find and enroll people into public/private programs
- 2. Provide medical homes and coordinated services
- 3. Arrange for access to affordable prescription drugs
- Expand care options for the uninsured and organize donated clinical care
- 5. Chronic disease management
- 6. Work with the business community to cover low-wage workers
- 7. Prioritize prevention and wellness services
- 8. Evaluate/Assess health status, disparities and effectiveness of services
